Details on the various local garden competitions organised by the committee, including the Best Kept Front Garden award, will also be available to anyone that decides to come along.

There will be opportunities on the day for members of the public to raise issues informally with project organisers, and discuss matters relating to local recycling and water conservation with Wealden District Council representatives, where information displays outlining their services will be available.

A spokesperson of Hailsham In Bloom said the public information day is an excellent opportunity for Hailsham residents to learn about the committee's current and future projects: "The open day will outline the committee's progress to date and future priorities relating to town floral displays, permanent landscaping and other horticultural achievements, biodiversity, local environmental quality and community participation."
