FISHING RULES AND CONDITIONS: HAILSHAM TOWN COUNCIL

- 1. Anglers must hold a current and valid Environment Agency Rod Licence (age 12 and over, available from Post Offices).
- 2. Fishing is permitted from the East bank only.
- 3. Only barbless hooks to be used.
- 4. No live bait or spinners to be used.
- 5. Only lead free weights to be used.
- 6. Landing nets must be used to land all fish which must be returned to the water swiftly and with due care.
- 7. No keep nets or carp sacks permitted.
- 8. 1kg limit on ground bait.
- 9. Unhooking mats must be used.
- 10. No catapults or maggot-pults.
- 11. Littering is prohibited. Please use the litter bins provided.
- 12. Fishing is permitted during daylight hours, as defined by published lighting up times.
- 13. Any angler found to be breaking any rule will be asked to leave the Country Park.
- 14. Your permit to fish is not transferable to any other person and must be produced on demand to any fisheries bailiff, police officer or representative of Hailsham Town Council.
