1. Apologies for Absence

- These were received from Mr H. Bell, Cllr B. Bentley, Cllr Mrs J. Bentley, Miss C. Bentley-Astor, Miss E. Collins, Cllr Mrs M. Rowe and Mrs J. Woodley.

2. Declaration of Interest

- None were received.

3. Approval of Minutes from Previous Meeting

- The minutes of the meeting held Wednesday 1st December 2010 were confirmed as a true and correct record.

4. Creation of Heritage Trail in Hailsham

- The Committee Clerk reported that Wealden District Council has confirmed which individual Heritage Trail sites will require planning permission for the installation of plaques on buildings/walls (Listed Building Consent), and the necessary application documents will be signed by the Chairman within the next few days and submitted to Wealden District Council thereafter for consideration. Permission to install plaques on the premises of eleven other Heritage Trail sites (including those owned or maintained by Hailsham Town Council) has also been granted, subject to approval of the final plaque design in the coming months.
- Quotations recently received for the design and layout of the Hailsham Heritage Map and Guide were circulated to all members present and a successful tenderer was agreed.

5. School Plant Nursery Creation Project

- There was nothing further to report on the plant nursery creation project.

6. Hailsham East Recycling Mural Displays

- The Committee Clerk reported that work by the Young Farmers' Youth Club on the repainting of the recycling centre murals located next to Hailsham East Community Centre will commence in the coming weeks, once the necessary spray paints and other equipment have been sourced. Quotations received for the purchase of spray paints will be presented at the next Sub-Committee meeting.

7. Any Other Business

- The Committee Clerk reiterated from the previous Sub-Committee meeting that the

Hailsham Pavilion has agreed to the screening of *Fergully: The Last Rainforest* on the morning of Saturday 26th February 2011 (during the school half-term week). Free hire of the venue has been confirmed, and any expenses (e.g. film hire) and profits will be shared on a 50/50 basis.

- Several A4 posters advertising the event have been produced, which will be distributed on the Town Council public notice-boards and other sites around the town centre as soon as possible.
