230 **Confirmation of Minutes**

RESOLVED that the minutes of the meeting of the Planning Consultative Panel held on Thursday 14th April 2011 Ref: 10/4/217-226 was confirmed as a correct record.

231 **Matters Arising**

The Chairman advised that at the Annual Town Meeting in April, a member of the public had expressed concern at the proposed application for two dwellings at land adjacent Troon Cottages, stating that the land was a habitat for bats and newts. The Chairman advised that a full environmental report had been carried out and no newts had been found.

A copy of a letter from the Chamber of Commerce sent to Wealden District Council and copied to Hailsham Town Council was circulated to the Panel, stating that the Chamber of Commerce are opposed to the proposed Quintins Car Park development.

Change of use to form extension to metal recycling facility together with alterations to the existing site layout.

The Town council has no objections, subject to the status of the footpath crossing the edge of the application boundary. If the footpath has public right of way status it must be retained.

Hailsham Town Council would like to make the following observations on the application:

i) The application is contrary to HG4 in the Non Statutory Plan as the affordable housing should be "pepper potted" throughout the development

ii) The Town Council would request to know why Phases 2 and 3 are being built without any affordable housing

iii) It should be a condition of any planning consent that the road extends to the outer edges of both ends of the development, however the road in the proposed plan is not extended to the outer edge of the boundary development

Due to the size and bulk of the garden shed, the Town Council would recommend that a condition is placed on the property stating that the garden shed cannot be used for residential use or additional accommodation.
