Residents And Visitors Invited To Children's Themed Market

Final preparations are being made for Hailsham's Children's Theme Market which takes place in the town centre on Saturday 27 June from 9.30am and organisers are confident that it will be a great family event offering something for everyone.

The market will feature stalls selling a wide range of fine food, gifts, jewellery and accessories from local traders, as well as items of interest to children including toys, crafts, confectionery and much more.

There will be live entertainment throughout the day with the South of Saturn Band performing from 12pm–1pm (also from 1.30pm-2.30pm) and the Hailsham Parish Church Youth Band showing from 3pm-3.30pm.

There will be family activities available throughout the day including a Camel Rodeo from 10am to 4pm and Hailsham FM will also be attending the event.

Councillor Amanda O' Rawe, Deputy Town Mayor and Chairman of the Town Council's Communities Committee said: "The special Children's Market will be a chance for children and parents from all over Hailsham and neighbouring towns to get together and enjoy some good old-fashioned street market culture."
