INTERMENTS

The fee payments and sums set out below apply:

Column (1) Parishioner: Where the person to be interred or in respect of whom the right is granted, is an inhabitant or parishioner of the parish of Hailsham, for any 5 years during the preceding 10 years may be buried as a parishioner and if the deceased's spouse had previously been buried in the cemetery as a parishioner, then the deceased should also be considered as a parishioner. Column (2) Non-parishioner: Persons were living outside the parish.

The fees apply where the interment is made between the hours of 10.00am and 3.00pm, Monday to Friday.

The fees for interment are inclusive of grave digging.

No charge is made for the interment of a stillborn child or of a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed one year.
