TITLE OF REPORT: Events on Western Road Recreation Ground
To agree three dates for summer events to be held on the Recreation Ground

BACKGROUND:

The Town Council has been approached recently to give permission to allow events to be held on Western Road Recreation Ground, such as the Bonfire Event Fun Day and ESCC 999 event

Councillors are asked to consider allocating three dates for events in the summer, which can be agreed as a policy as dates for summer events to be held on Western Road Recreation Ground.

This will prevent the need for a request to be taken to the Assets Committee each time permission is asked to hold an event on Western Road Recreation Ground

The Recreation Ground is used by the Cricket Club for league matches in the summer on a Saturday so the dates offered would be Sundays only

It is advisable to agree dates later in the Summer to ensure as much as possible that the ground is dry and vehicles will therefore not cause any damage to the ground

Any proposed events would have to be vetted by the Town Council Officers to ensure they are suitable “family events” and the organisers of the event must liaise with the Town Council and Cricket Club at all times

Any proposed events will also be agreed subject to the monitoring of the wetness of the recreation ground at a time before the event.

Changes to the layout of any proposed event will be made if necessary, if the ground is too wet, to prevent damage to the ground

The proposed dates are :

The last Sunday in June, the last Sunday in July and the last Sunday in August

(The last Sunday in June 2024 has already been agreed for the Bonfire Society event)

This proposal has the support of the Deputy Town Clerk and Works Manager

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

There will be no cost to the Council
