46 **Declarations of Interest**

C. Bryant declared a personal interest in the item discussing the Bonfire Society as he is a member of the Bonfire Society.

47 Confirmation of Minutes

M. Caira spoke in relation to the Stand Proud event. He advised the Council would be able to organise the rainbow flag on the War Memorial but that the Council may not have the staff resources to organise the "Best Dressed Window" competition.

It was agreed to defer a decision on the report until the next meeting in September.

A Ricketts spoke about the Stand Proud event and considered she would like to know what age group of children are involved in the event.

50 **Street Market**

M. Caira advised that the Link Coffee shop has been taken over by Bay Tree Foods.

He reported that this is the 3rd street trader that has opened a business in the Town so this was very positive news.

51 <u>Hailsham Forward</u>

Hailsham Forward are currently supporting the Eastwell project and Hailsham BID.

The Health and Wellbeing Hub from Hailsham Aspires is also being discussed, with Hailsham Forward aiming to provide some constructive feedback for a meeting in September.

The Eastwell Place Bridge Project has been a remarkable success and a large amount of artwork has been submitted in the competition for artwork to be placed on the bridge.

The ribbon cutting event will be held on the bridge on 9th September and this will reveal which art work submissions were chosen to be placed on the bridge.

T. Biggin reported that Wealden Council had been very supportive of the project and he thanked the Town Council again for their help.
