# 137 Christmas Market

Members agreed to hold the 2024 market on Saturday 14th December

Members discussed the recent Christmas market, which had been moved indoors to the Civic Centre, due to heavy winds and rain on the day, as it was not possible to hold the event outside. The feedback from traders had been extremely positive and the footfall had been consistent throughout the day, considering the venue had to be changed at the last minute.

Many traders had confirmed they would like the event held indoors in the future, although some traders stated they would still rather trade outside if possible.

Unfortunately the parade could not go ahead due to the bad weather and although the Best Dressed Ef and Best Dressed Dog competitions still went ahead at the Cattle Market, there were no entries.

Members discussed the benefits of holding the event indoors and considered that the event could be bigger and better if held both indoors and outdoors. It was agreed to look into holding the 2024 Christmas market in both the High Street and also indoors in the Civic Centre.

D. Sinden advised that the footfall for the free Wealden Brass concert in the Church had been the biggest ever, so this was not affected by holding the Christmas market indoors.
