Response to Wealden Local Plan/Hailsham Neighbourhood Development Plan

6.1 Debate took place on whether the Neighbourhood Plan Committee had delegated authority to reply directly to Wealden District Council on their Local Plan. On checking Standing Orders, it was agreed that it was permissible to do so.

The Chairman said that Hailsham Town Council had until 10th May to submit a written response to the Wealden Local Plan. It was agreed that the Communications Officer add a post to the Hailsham Town Council Facebook account advising the public that the Local Plan is available to look at in the Hailsham Town Council offices.

Troy Planning had quoted between £6,500 and £7,500 to respond on HTC's behalf to the Wealden Local Plan and to update the Neighbourhood Plan. This was within the current budget.

6.2 **RESOLVED** to employ the services of Troy Planning at a cost of between £6,500 and £7,500 to respond to the Wealden Local Plan and to update Hailsham Town Council's Neighbourhood Development Plan.
