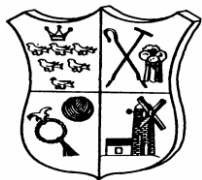

- The re-painting of the letters on the War Memorial was discussed and members were advised this will be taken to Full Council the following week to ask for

permission for the funding for the work
